



How – To Log into Fair

Entry

1. Go to <http://TiogaCountyFairNY.fairentry.com>

FFA and Open Show Members ONLY:

- You are going to create a Fair Entry account if you do not already have one.
 1. If you **already** have an existing fair entry account – log in using those credentials
 2. If you do not have a Fair Entry account
 - a. Click on “Not in 4-HOnline and need to create a Fair Entry exhibitor account?”
 - b. Follow the steps to create an account (email, password, etc.)
 - c. Once your account is created, use it to log into Fair Entry and begin the registration process.
